

RESOLUTION NO. 8-2-11 R

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING TEMPORARY JUSTICE COURT JUDGES

WHEREAS, a conflict of interest, an appearance of impropriety, or an absence may on occasion affect the ability of the Kanab City Justice Court Judge to hear a case; and

WHEREAS, Utah Code Annotated 78A-7-208 states that the appointing authority may appoint another justice court judge currently holding office within the judicial district to serve as a temporary justice court judge in the cases described above; and

WHEREAS, there are three other justice court judges in Kane County who might if the need arises be available in order for one of their number to be selected as substitute justice court judge in place of the Kanab City Justice Court Judge if he should ever have to recuse himself or otherwise become absent or disqualified to hear a Kanab City case;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KANAB UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

In the event that the Kanab City Justice Court Judge is absent or disqualified, the following individuals are appointed as temporary justice court judges:

The Honorable F. Kirk Heaton, Kane County Justice Court Judge
The Honorable Peter J. Thompson, Big Water Justice Court Judge
The Honorable Steven Wallace, Orderville Justice Court Judge
Any other Justice Court Judge within the 6th Judicial District hereafter appointed.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Kanab City Council the 9th day of August, 2011. This ordinance shall be effective upon passage.
